## **Bulletin 1 – 3 November 2010**

### **Project to Develop & Distribute to Affiliated Clubs a Teaching Resource Specific to Beginners' Bridge Lessons**

Representative members of the NZ Bridge Board and Regional Teacher Representatives met in Wellington on Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> October to discuss and determine a strategy for the above. NZ Bridge has budgeted for a significant sum of money to be allocated over a three year period to provide Clubs with Teaching Resource & Teacher support (where required) to assist them initially with Beginner Player Recruitment & Retention.

### **Assembly of Teaching Resources / Timeline 30<sup>th</sup> November 2010**

During the time available a variety of resources will be gathered together following which a user friendly package will be compiled ready for release in February 2011.

All Clubs are invited to provide comment / input on what resource(s) they consider would be of most use to them before expiry of this timeline.

### **Regional Conference / February 12<sup>th</sup> 2011**

At this time it is envisaged a "Draft Package" would be available for viewing and comment at this meeting. It is intended that the "Final Package" would be ready for release in early March 2011.

### **Work In Progress**

It is important to remember that this Project is in the initial stages and will continue on as a "Work in Progress". It represents commitment and investment by NZ Bridge in the grass roots of the organisation and has a focus of working with member Clubs to achieve increased membership which has short and long-term benefits for the Clubs & NZ Bridge.

It is intended that future Bulletins will be released updating Clubs on the progress of this Project.
