REPORT FROM THE WELLINGTON REGIONAL CONFERENCE

- Rosaleen Koch attended the August Regional Conference and presented a written summary of the conference
- Items of interest were:

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP RETURNS

- Unfortunately not all clubs filed a return with NZB and it was felt at the regional conference that some clubs were not honest with the correct number of paid up members at their club. NZB are working through the known delinquent clubs
- The annual membership return is useful as they currently provide statistics regarding the number of beginner lessons clubs hold throughout the year; number of people taking the lessons; the conversion numbers to become members; and the retention of members
- There is also other information that may be required for future annual returns

CHANGE OF NAME

- NZB agreed to change the name of the Auckland Regional Committee to AUCKLAND/NORTHLAND REGIONAL COMMITTEE thus better describing the geographical location
- With the name change, it was expressed that representation from Northland at the Regional meetings would be welcomed
- Northland has always been entitled to send a nomination for the committee but in recent years has not done so. As the current committee is a good working one, if they decide in the future to do so, then they would need to guarantee their nominated person, or proxy, would attend the majority of meetings and not send in an apology each time
- Northland Clubs are always sent a copy of the minutes but in future a copy of the agenda and also the minutes will be sent to Northland Board Member Patsy Walters

GENERAL BUSINESS

 The ANRC agreed not to charge the Royle Epsom club for 8 sets of boards for their 24 hour charity bridge marathon to be held from 6 pm Friday 30th September to 6 pm Saturday 1st October. Joy Morcom will be paid for making up the boards. The money raised will go to Alzheimers Auckland.
