General Business:

1: Strategic plan: Agreed to make a strategic plan for the region, using Alan Turner's template. This will require a meeting apart from a tournament.

- 2: Email from Rona Driscoll re SI Teams. The SI Teams are scheduled to rotate between the 3 SI Regions; and NZ Bridge wish it to be run always in February, for NZ trials purposes. This would clash 1 year in 3 with the region's 10A teams. Agreed to ask to hold the SI Teams 1 year in 3; and that year run the 10A teams later in the year.
- 3: A coaching seminar will be held (after the Marlborough Intermediate) on Sunday 16 June; any intermediate and junior player in the region may attend. Maurice Carter will be the tutor. Advertise it on the entry notice for the tournament; and send out a separate flyer.

- 4: 2014 tournaments: Motueka confirmed that they wanted the first Saturday in May for the Intermediate Pairs and the first Saturday August for the Margaret Talley Memorial 5A Picton have not yet decided on the date for the Howorth Cup. It could be the Sunday after the Marlborough or Picton Intermediate. Alternatively a stand alone date could be chosen.
- 5: Sponsorship: A vote of thanks was passed to the Nelson Building Society for sponsoring the Centre Island Pairs at Picton in July. Also for supporting tournaments in the Nelson and Buller areas Thanks were also given to Gary Howard for acting as liaison between the Region and the NBS.
