The inward correspondence is received and the outward approved, moved Evelyn Hurley seconded Alan Doddridge carried.

Finance: Bank balance as at 31/7/2013, 000 Act. \$4 491.14 and 025 Act. \$9,695.50

Bryan Green and Evelyn Hurley that the following cheques be ratified, carried. Payment to IRD \$230.40, to NZBridge \$700 club championships and \$720 for IP, Travel to D. Nightingale \$74 and travel and expenses to D. Mackay \$85

Bryan Green moved and Alan Doddridge seconded that the following expenses be met. Approval given to support the youth players who went to the Christchurch weekend at the rate of \$50 each (half of their cost) and travel payment agreed to which ever pair wins the rubber bridge i.e. either \$105 or \$75. Expenses re youth team at Hamilton were approved to meet accommodation expenses, travel and \$200 for the NPC, carried \$3 998.00 was the levy share received by the region from NZBridge. <u>IPs</u> The position of Chef du Mission was discussed. Val was concerned about the space at Wellington for the team to score up. The issue of substitute players was a point for discussion. No decision reached as to who should be the Chef du Mission. (need a decision by the end of Sept.)

The Open, Womens and Seniors to be emailed and asked to appoint between themselves a team captain

The Intermediate Team is being mentored by Scott and Debbie Smith which the committee appreciates. Evelyn to liaise with this group. Intermediates to be encouraged to play in the Napier Teams.

Val requested email contact information for all the pairs in the IP and she would be prepared to send them out 100 bidding scenarios. The training day for this event has been cancelled due to not sufficient interest.

<u>Youth Players:</u> Contact to be made in an effort to secure a youth team for 2013. Aware not all players are available this year.

<u>Tournaments:</u> Fullarton teams this was a successful event with 18 teams playing. Evelyn questioned whether there was a trophy and Don said yes and he would investigate where it was currently. Val was the CD representative on the Match Committee and admitted she had not been proactive. The Wanganui Club to be asked for a financial breakdown for this event as they held it on behalf of the CDRC.

Clubs were notified earlier in the year who the CD committee representatives would be for the regional events for 2013 and they need to have these members in the loop. The guideline for hosting clubs to be updated and placed on the website after the next committee meeting. Flyers for regional events should go onto the website. A reminder to clubs that it is expected that a third of income should go back to players in the form of prize money
