There are five immediate winners (two spades, two hearts and a club). Diamonds offer some hope of four tricks if you lead towards the ♦KQ hoping North has the ace. Do not lead a diamond from the East hand.

It is probably wise to duck the first lead then take the second heart with the Ace in your hand.



Two reasons for this. You keep an entry in Dummy and you can then pow play up to the AQIf North plays low and you diamond honour holds, return to your hand with a spade and lead a second diamond. If North plays low, win in Dummy and play the suit again hoping North had three diamonds to the ace. Now Dummy makes four diamonds.
