TEACHERS' WEEKEND IN CHRISTCHURCH

- 33 attended the workshop at the beginning of February
- Only two from the Northland/Auckland area were present
- Beginner modules are now online
- Refresher modules will go online in the next few months
- NZB will hold the workshop every two years, therefore Regions are asked to hold a one day workshop prior to the start of lessons in February 2015
- ANRC agreed this would happen and, nearer the time, Richard Solomon will contact all clubs in the region to ascertain the names of those teaching beginner lessons and invite them to the workshop
- An important part of the workshop is the retention of members as this appears to be an ongoing problem for most clubs
- Peter Bowyer has been asked by NZB to set up a group email for Teachers, similar to the Directors one which works very successfully

REGIONAL CONFERENCE – Christchurch 6th February 2014

- Peter Bowyer attended the conference on behalf of the ANRC and gave an overview of the discussions that took place
- NZB will forward minutes of the meeting to all clubs
- The next Regional Conference is in Wellington Sunday 29th June

YOUTH PLAYER SUBSIDIES

- As from 9th February 2014 there is a change of policy regarding ANRC subsidies for the Youth players
- ANRC Youth players playing with any youth player can claim 50% of their New Zealand tournament entry fees
- A Youth play playing with a non-Youth player can claim 25% of the New Zealand tournament entry fee
- This policy excludes National Congress fees
- When Youth players are making a claim, they must submit a receipt from the tournament venue

YOUTH PLAYERS

- Youth players will be trialling for the NZ Youth Team at the South Island Teams event in Christchurch
- The annual Youth Weekend is August 1/3 at Auckland Club
- Schools: In 2014 Macleans College and Auckland Grammar will continue; Babs-Merel will continue her home schooling group in Terms 2 and 3; Fay Irwin from Papatoetoe club has been pro-active in contacting the President of the NZ Association of Intermediate & Middle Schools asking for mini bridge to be part of the South Auckland school curriculum as an enhancement to students' Maths programme

DIRECTING SEMINAR

• It was decided there will be no directing seminar in 2014 but there may be one in 2015

GENERAL BUSINESS

SYSTEM CARD FOR JUNIOR TOURNAMENTS

- Papakura asked if Junior tournament players could be exempt from completing a system card
- Graham Wakefield advised this is an NZB matter and he would contact Papakura Club
- However the answer is that from 1st March 2014 junior players must complete the two outside parts of the system card as this would probably help the players to understand and reaffirm their system
- Graham also advised the NZB Board is intending to provide a pre-filled card for beginners who have been taught to play the system/s exactly as per the Teaching Notes published by NZB and used by many of the bridge teachers
