# GRADINGS

- It was mentioned that there is confusion in the NZB manual regarding Open grade. Page E6 states: "Open – any player with more than 100 Rating Points". Presumably this means players move to Open with 101 points (as with Intermediate 31 points). Clarification required from NZB ANGELA
- The above two items to be forwarded as agenda items for the Regional Conference in February

• There was general discussion on the new Open players having to play against the top Open players. If there were more 8B Open tournaments perhaps restrict two players with Life Master status and above from partnering for the event but they could partner another Open player of lesser ranking. This could help the situation. It was also commented that with the number of Restricted tournaments this could be a reason why there are less 8B tournaments.

- At the February and November Interclub sessions the ARC Chairman or substitute will introduce/close the session
