## **BRIDGE WORKSHOPS**

### **Auckland**

- The ANRC held a workshop on Sat/Sun 24/25 March at Howick Club for Intermediates and keen Juniors facilitated by Richard Solomon. 72 people attended and several were turned away as the maximum number had been reached
- There was a profit of \$350
- It was well worthwhile and the evaluation forms gave very positive feedback plus some good recommendations

### **Northland**

- As several eager players were turned away – especially from Northland – a similar seminar will be at the Kerikeri Bridge Club Sat/Sun 30 June/1<sup>st</sup> July. Richard will facilitate
- Sue Brown, Northland representative for the seminar asked that the ANRC assist with their expenses. Richard offered to leave the committee meeting while this was discussed. The ANRC agreed to provide the prizes, pay travelling and photo-coping expenses and underwrite the weekend up to \$500. Organisers to be advised
- There will be a charge of \$5 for non-workshop attendees wishing to play bridge on the Saturday evening

- Auckland youth players attending will be subsidised by \$50 from the ANRC
- Ashley Bach is holding an invitational youth workshop May 12/13 at Auckland Club. The cost is \$100. The ANRC will subsidise Auckland youth players by \$50
- For youth players to be eligible for the \$50 subsidy (for both weekends) it was agreed they should be members of a club and Akarana club was suggested. They would need to be considered as full members and receive all information available to Akarana members plus access to their website. Being members of a club and affiliated to NZB may encourage them to participate in tournaments and be more involved with the game. Richard to follow up. **RICHARD**
- Susan Humphries is running youth bridge sessions on alternate Sundays from 4-7 pm. ANRC pays for any catering expenses ie fruit juice, biscuits

## **BRIDGE PLAYERS PLAYING IN AUSTRALIA**

- Graham Wakefield advised that currently NZ B members playing tournaments in Australia had the choice of whether or not to convert their Masterpoints to NZ. He advised NZB was currently discussing that Masterpoints gained in Australia be automatically converted to NZ as there were grade issues for those players not converting their points
