GENERAL BUSINESS

- Through Tony Morcom, Patrick Carter thanked the ANRC for paying his and his partner's entry to the Main Centre Teams/Pairs in July. This was a thank you from the ANRC for Patrick's tireless work in organising the tournament schedule over the last few years
- With the change in grading criteria, the drop in the number of tournament players and to encourage new Open players to enter A point tournaments, it was suggested that clubs could perhaps offer an additional prize level for players with under 50A or 100A points. This would, of course, be an individual club decision.
