CLUB NUMBERS

- The annual returns received from clubs showed the base membership was down by just over 600 from last year. A most disappointing figure. The current number of NZB players is around 13,000
- All club sessions must be part of the Masterpoint scheme
- The Masterpoint revenue has increased from last year but the number of membership levies has decreased

OPENING BID ANNOUNCEMENTS

 Announcing the 1C and 1NT opening bid will come into effect at all club sessions and tournaments from 1st May 2013. NZB will send a bulletin to clubs advising this will happen

SYSTEM CARDS

- The common system card for NZ and Australia is finalised and <u>must</u> be used by ALL tournament players from 1st July 2013
- Clubs will be encouraged to ask their members to use the system card but it will not be mandatory
- Hard copies to be sent to all clubs and sometime soon the system card can be downloaded from the NZB website
- There will be subtle changes on the system card relating to NZ and Australia, ie relevant logos
- The WBF system card will not be used in NZ and Australia unless it is an international tournament
