YOUTH BRIDGE

- NZB is subsidising the players and, as the cost of \$100 includes airfares, accommodation and meals,
 ANRC will not subsidise further
- Macleans College, McAuley High and Pakuranga College held a small tournament at Howick Club on Sunday 7th July from 10 am to noon. There were five tables and everyone had a good time

MASTERPOINT CHARGES

- Auckland Club President Russell Watt was invited to the committee meeting to participate in the discussion as to why the ANRC should continue to pay masterpoint charges for 10A and above tournaments
- There was robust discussion on the subject
- The committee decided from 1st January 2014, clubs hosting 10A tournaments and above need to build the masterpoint charges into their entry fee. However, the ANRC decided they will reimburse the host club 50% of the tournament MP costs

DIRECTING SEMINAR held 22/23 June 2013 at Howick Club

- Positive feedback was received regarding the seminar facilitated by Allan Joseph
- The emphasis on the Saturday was directing at club level and on the Sunday the emphasis was for those wishing to become Tournament Directors
- It was felt the seminar was advantageous to the attendees and should be repeated in the future

BEGINNER LESSONS SUBSIDY

- The previous policy that ANRC clubs could claim a maximum of \$150 per annum for advertising costs (or 50% of actual cost whichever the lower) has now changed to be in line with NZB regulations. From now on, only clubs with less than 100 members can claim the \$150 maximum from the ANRC Coaching Grant
- Franklin Club recently claimed for a substantial amount of costs for their beginner lessons. They will be advised that the maximum advertising cost of \$150 will be refunded to them
