The Minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 19 March 2013

Matters arising

Congress – David Morel has agreed to supervise the caddies. He will also be approached re acting as Congress Manager. Joan will assist Heather with her duties during the teams event. Allan commented that there has been a problem in the past in posting teams events on the website. The Wellington website will be used initially and the results transferred later to the regional website.

Allan is to suggest to the Wellington Club that for all of these major events there be an IT person separate from the Director as these are two quite separate and major roles.

Joan reported that we were too late applying for Nescafe sponsorship but that they had sent a spot prize. New World Thorndon had also provided a \$50.00 voucher.

Heather reported a healthy and increasing operating suplus for the year ended 31 March 1913.

Finance

Income for the year ended 31 March 2013: \$16,988.00 Total expenditure for the year ended 31 March 2013 \$11,797.00

Operating surplus: \$5191.00.

This gives the Regional Committee a balance of \$26,603.00.

Tony reported that because of the increased numbers playing interclub and the increase in table money, Interclub was likely to return a profit of about \$3,000 this year. It was also mentioned that there would be less outlay on the IPs this year as they were being held in Wellington.

Because of all of the above, the general feeling of the meeting was that more funds need to be returned to the region. Some ways of doing this were discussed.

Debrief on Main Centre Pairs - The Wellington Club will be working with Allan and others concerned to sort out the issues that Joan have existed in the past related to barometer scoring. Re Pat Carter's letter, it was stressed that for these events the flyer needed to give an indication of finishing time and be sent out at least seven weeks before the event. Allan Draft 2014 Wellington tournament schedule - this was endorsed and has been sent out to the clubs. Masterton Open - Allan raised the issue of slow scoring at the recent Masterton Open Tournament. Two suggestions made were that WRC subsidize the cost of hiring bridge pads or that we purchase some. Allan is to check the cost to Masterton of hiring bridge pads from the SWCBC. Interclub - It has been agreed that directors will be paid \$62 per session backdated to the first session. Allan Dinnie, Tony and Allan will produce a seating plan for each of the clubrooms being used. To help the directors participants will be reminded to leave their table money at their home table. Tony tabled a comprehensive paper on interclub costings for 2013. **Teachers Seminar –** The 10th November has been suggested for Dinnie, Tony Allan this forum which the Regional Committee will sponsor. Tony will ask the teachers to suggest a suitable date and find a facilitator. **Coaching** – Dinnie suggested that there was a need for more dirctor's coaching and that an open session on appeals would be useful.
