 - Some love the changes







- Posters, entry links and booking details can be added to any tournament on request of the club







What is coming?

Clubs will be able to:

- amend their own club page on the NZB website
- add details to their tournaments (NB: can't change the date)
- use the NZB Tournament booking system to take entries if they so wish to (just like the Congress events)
- manage members online
- automatically upload their club's Masterpoints
- receive automatic invoices

NZBrîdge

What is coming?

Membership

Clubs will be able to:

- allocate computer numbers to new players
- change the status of a player from "active" to "inactive" or vice versa
- remove members or transfer them to another club

What is coming?

Masterpoint uploads

Clubs will be able to:

- automatically process their Masterpoints immediately after an event
- reduce manual input by clubs and NZB

NB: The three main scoring software providers in NZ have been asked for their input

Invoicing

Clubs will be able to:


- have their invoices automatically generated quarterly from the Masterpoint and membership updates
- have their invoices emailed to clubs
- be able to view their invoices on the NZB website




