GENERAL

Teacher's Conference on Sunday 29th January.

Programme circulated. Agreement to reimburse Crockfords for expenses up to \$200. Proposed that in future we invite unaffiliated clubs to this event.

- Inter-Provincials review.

Everything went smoothly, no issues in Dunedin. We need to provide the same support for K Wooles in 2017. With late withdrawal in the Intermediate Team, it was discussed that we should be providing more training for the top Intermediates, maybe a private group. This can dovetail into a plan for more training for all Ints and Juniors.

- Charity Pairs review.

The match committee had agreed that the CRC would pay for the masterpoints, but we need to revisit this with the CRC committee in 2017 and clarify with Crockfords who is paying and how it is coded to NZ Bridge. We could look at more outside assistance for 2017, Lions catering ? Swiss Pairs worked well.

- Website.

We have had a few problems this month after the database was updated, and the email changed to CRC. We will have to do a roll-back to January 18th to fix the tournament drop-down entry list of tournaments. We have all current entries recorded.

- Banking.

Moved that the Owners of the CRC BNZ accounts be changed to Laura Stephen and Giles Hancock. CARRIED We will then need to change the signatories.

- Vacancy.

We have only had one application for the advertised vacancy, and given no other applications coming in before 31st January, we will recommend Mary Buckland be appointed to the Canterbury Regional Committee.
