

# Minimum, Invitational and Game Force (GF) Bids

### **Teacher Notes**

It is recommended you take extra time with this lesson and possibly repeat it the following session and have the players sit in the opposite direction

#### Lesson Content

- Opener's Rebids page 1 of Student Notes
- Responder's Rebids page 2 of Student Notes

### Main Points to Emphasise

Opener's and Responder's rebids are prioritised as follows:

- support partner
- rebid NT
- bid a new suit
- rebid same suit

Every rebid is minimum, invitational or forcing.

Responder's rebid usually sets the final contract.

## **Lesson Progression**

Teach Opener's Rebids first Emphasise that all rebids show **shape as well as strength.** 

> Play hands 1-4 Supper time

## **After Supper**

- Teach Responder's Rebids the same priorities are followed as above:
- Every rebid is minimum, invitational or forcing.
- Again emphasise that all rebids show shape and strength.

Play hands 5-8
