



Lesson Content

Two types of Double:

- 1. Take-out Double
- 2. Penalty Double

Main Points to Emphasise

- Most doubles at the 1 and 2-level are take-out.
- Take-out doubles must show shortage in opponent's suit (0-2 cards).
- Take-out doubles show at least two unbid suits, preferably two 4-card suits.
- A penalty double is used in specific situations you expect to defeat the contract.
- A take-out double can be passed for penalties when partner has a lot of the opponent's suit.
- Take-out doubles are sometimes called Negative Doubles and Reopening Doubles.
