

INTERMEDIATE LESSON 3: STUDENT NOTES

Escape over 1NT Doubled

Responder's Actions

Pass willing to play 1NT doubled, shows 8+ HCP XX Shows any single suited hand, 5+ suit opener must bid 2.4 (if the opposition have passed) responder then passes with clubs or bids their long suit Shows clubs and a higher suit, 4/4 shape 2* opener passes with 3+ clubs or bids their next 3+ suit (with a doubleton club) _ 2 Shows diamonds and a higher suit, 4/4 shape opener passes with 3+ diamonds or bids their next 3+ suit (with a doubleton diamond) Shows hearts and spades, 4/4 shape 2♥ opener chooses their longer major 2♠ Shows 5+ spades, slightly better hand than going through XX

General Principles

- If the opponents bid a suit at any time, pass with relief!
- It is important to understand, when responder shows two 4-card suits, that the partnership is looking for a 4-3 or better fit.
- Opener only bids if they have a doubleton in partner's 1st bid suit. Exception: when responder shows both majors with 2*
- If responder has a five **and** a four card suit, it is better to XX to show the five card suit, rather than trying to show both suits.
