# IP Players details to Christchurch Bridge Club

### 2020 Planning:

## **Directing Seminar**

We are fortunate to have Allan Joseph for another year.

The focus will be on people who direct at club level who not necessarily want to do an exam. This is likely to be a 2-day course. The first half will be on Sunday 9 February in Rotorua, the day after the Kelly Peirse (which Allan will direct). The second half of the course is likely to be run in Cambridge on a date yet to be confirmed.

### **Open Restricted Pairs**

After consultation with NZ Bridge, we are hoping to introduce two new Restricted Open 8B pairs events in 2020.

These are subject to discussion with the host clubs, but if accepted would run parallel to the 10A Pairs at the Tauranga and Hamilton Congresses. "Restricted Open" is as yet not completely defined, but it is likely to be the same as was used at National Congress, ie for players of National Master rank and below. For consistency we wish to use the same criteria.

### **Thames Festival**

Will be held at a new venue, namely the Rugby & Sports Club, which can be seen on the left hand side of the main road into town, just before the bridge.

### Rubber Bridge - Rubber Ducky Day

Likely to be in Putaruru again, subject to confirmation, on Sunday 5 April.

After the triumph of "our" Jo and Sam Simpson at National Congress, we are hoping for even more participating pairs in 2020.

Participating players must be available to play at Congress should they win the Waikato Bays Rubber Ducky competition.

### **IP Trials**

The Open, Women and Senior trials entry will be by TEAM entry.

The Intermediate trials entry will remain a pairs entry.

Tauranga will be hosting the event again on Saturday 9 and Sunday 10 May.

Format will depend on the number of entries.

### **WBRC Elections**

Regional Committee election will be held in March/April.

At least two current committee members will not be available for election.

### **Congress Sponsorship**

Despite a disappointing uptake this year, we will continue to sponsor 4 players to play at Congress in 2020 for the Thursday to Saturday package.

We ask the clubs to make the players more aware of this sponsorship by announcing this regularly at the beginning of their club sessions.

### Leagues

The **Junior League** attendance has been disappointing, especially given that we had drastically increased the prize pool this year. Therefore we are rationalizing the prize pool for all Leagues to 120.00 per session played. This means that for the Junior League, 2020 will have 6 x 120 as total prize pool and the **Intermediate League** will have 8 x 120 as total prize pool.

We are also introducing a new **Restricted Open League**. This is aimed to encourage players of a National Master rank or less to participate in certain tournaments of 8B, 3A and 5A. The introduction came about after a current Intermediate IP team player offered sponsorship for events where they, freshly Open grade players, don't have to play against the "big guns". Points will be awarded to WB clubs registered players who play with a WB club registered player, similar to the Junior and Intermediate Leagues. Players must be of the National Master rank or lower at the start of the year to be able to participate in the Restricted Open League. The points of the league will also be calculated using Compass.

The events which will be included in the ROL are:

25 January: Tauranga Congress Restricted open 8B pairs

14 March: Waihi all-grades 8B pairs

18 April: Mt Maunganui Multigrade Pairs

2-3 May: Taupo open 5A pairs
6 June: Morrinsville open 8B pairs
20 June: Rotorua open 5A pairs
25 July: Matamata open 5A pairs

10 October: Te Puke open 3A pairs
17 October: Taupo open 8B pairs

24 October: Hamilton Congress restricted open 8B pairs
