Schneideman Jug Pairs for non-qualifiers will be run in November/December.
The exact formats will be determined depending upon the number of teams entered and will be advised prior to play of the first session.

While it is not an official “A” point tournament it will be run as if it were an official NZ Bridge Inc tournament except for the substitution rules. Playing on any night of the event constitutes agreement to be bound by NZ Bridge Inc tournament regulations except where expressly varied by this notice. Please note page 11 of the WBC Programme relating to systems. Also system cards must be carried at all times.

Substitution Rules

Teams may be up to 6 named persons and there is no limit as to the number of nights those team members may play, either in the qualifying rounds or finals. In addition during the qualifying rounds a team may have up to 2 substitutions on each night so long as 2 of the nominated team play on any one night. Players (whether members or non-members) can substitute for more than one team during the qualifying rounds without restriction. For the finals in the **case of emergencies** 1 substitute for each night is permissible.
