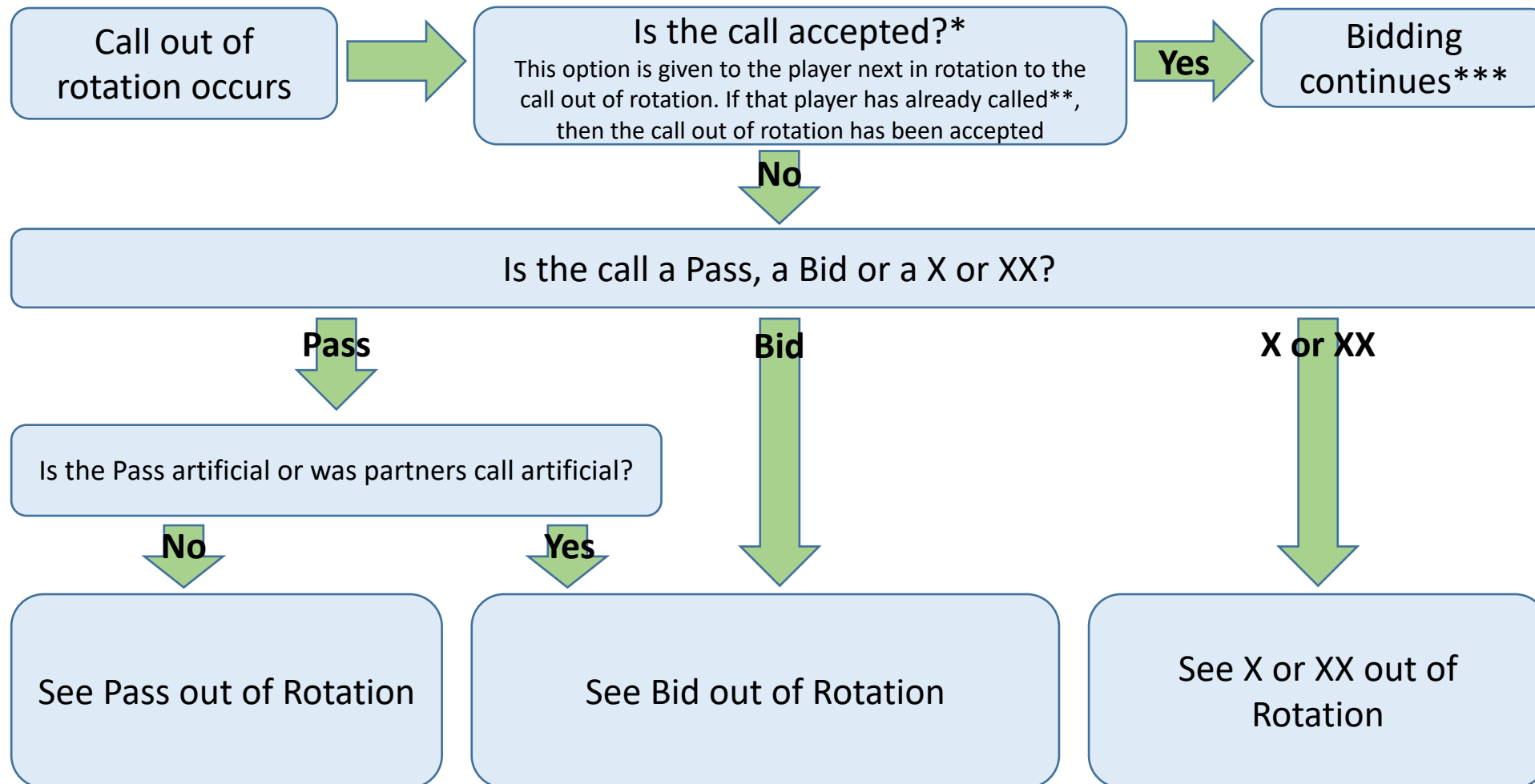


# Director's Quick Reference Guide

## Call Out of Rotation (Laws 29–32)



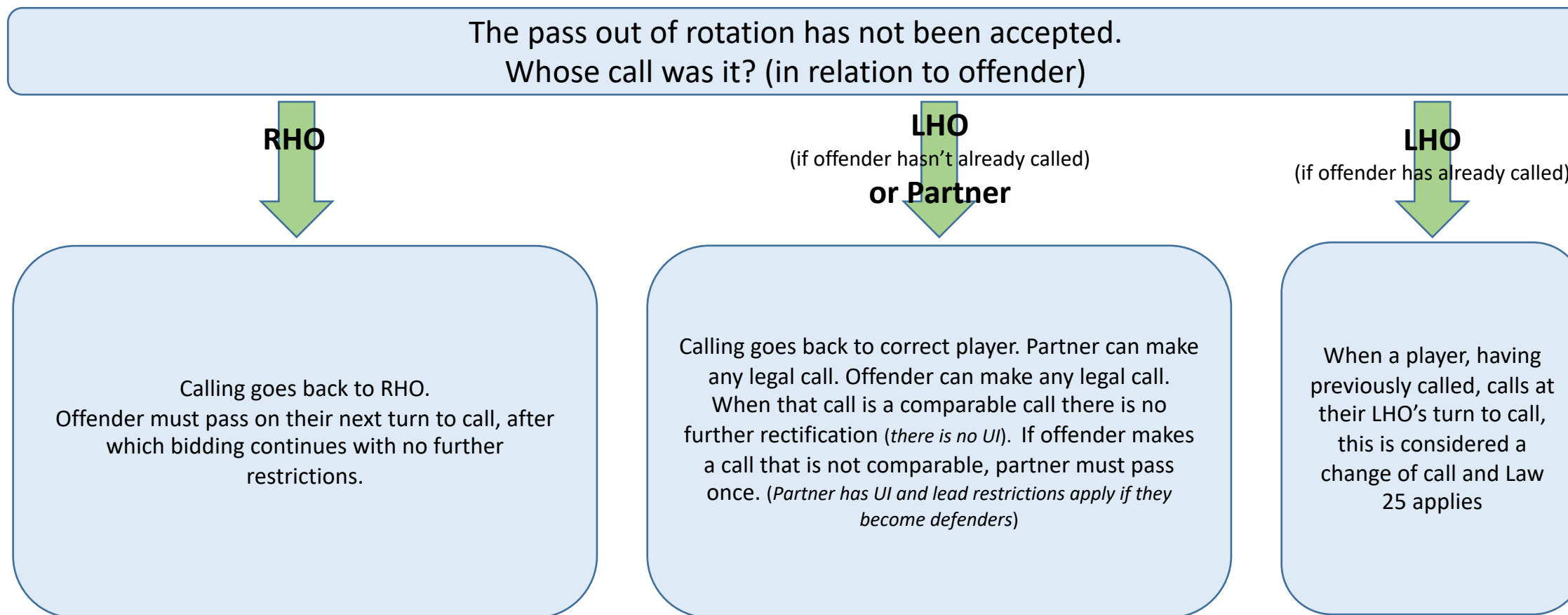
\*An inadmissible X or XX may never be accepted – see Law 36B4

\*\*When that call was made by a player at their legal turn to call then Law 28B applies

\*\*\*When there are 3 consecutive passes, one of which was an accepted pass out of rotation see Law 17D3

## Bid Out of Rotation (Law 31)

A bid is a call that specifies a number and a denomination, or, for the purposes of this law, a pass with an artificial meaning or passing partner's artificial call.

The bid out of rotation has not been accepted.  
Whose call was it? (in relation to offender)

**RHO**



Calling goes back to RHO.  
**RHO passes** - offender must repeat their bid.  
**RHO bids** - offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (*there is no UI*). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, partner must pass once. (*Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders*)

**LHO**

(if offender hasn't already called)

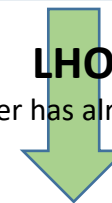
**or Partner**



Calling goes back to correct player. Partner can make any legal call. Offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (*there is no UI*). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, partner must pass once. (*Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders*)

**LHO**

(if offender has already called)



When a player, having previously called, calls at their LHO's turn to call, this is considered a change of call and Law 25 applies

## X or XX Out of Rotation (Law 32)

The X or XX out of rotation has not been accepted.\*  
Whose call was it? (in relation to offender)

**RHO**



Calling goes back to RHO.  
**RHO passes** - offender must repeat their bid.  
**RHO bids** - offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (*there is no UI*). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, partner must pass once. (*Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders*)

**LHO**

(if offender hasn't already called)

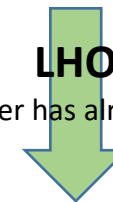
**or Partner**
