

*An inadmissible X or XX may never be accepted – see Law 36B4

**When that call was made by a player at their legal turn to call then Law 28B applies

***When there are 3 consecutive passes, one of which was an accepted pass out of rotation see Law 17D3

The pass out of rotation has not been accepted. Whose call was it? (in relation to offender)



ЦНО

(if offender hasn't already called)

or Partner

LHO (if offender has already called)

Calling goes back to RHO.

Offender must pass on their next turn to call, after which bidding continues with no further restrictions.

Calling goes back to correct player. Partner can make any legal call. Offender can make any legal call. When that call is a comparable call there is no further rectification (there is no UI). If offender makes a call that is not comparable, partner must pass once. (Partner has UI and lead restrictions apply if they become defenders)

When a player, having previously called, calls at their LHO's turn to call, this is considered a change of call and Law 25 applies



Director's Quick Reference Guide Bid Out of Rotation (Law 31)

A bid is a call that specifies a number and a denomination, or, for the purposes of this law, a pass with and artificial meaning or passing partners artificial call.
