Is the deck deficient (less than 52 cards) or do hands have more/less than 13 cards?

## Deck deficient

## More/Less than 13 cards

Is the card surplus (53+ cards) to the deck or has a card moved between hands

## Surplus Card

Card Moved

Has a call been made by an incorrect hand?

Find card(s) or reconstruct deal. Auction and play proceed with no change to bids/plays already made.

Remove the card and play with no change to bids/plays already made.

Has a player seen the card(s) of another player?

No

No

Return card to correct hand and play normally.

Return card to the correct hand, then play. If outcome affected, award adjusted score.\*

Is play complete?

No

**Director's Decision:** If it can be corrected and played, go ahead with no change of call (scores may be adjusted). Otherwise, award adjusted score\*.

Result is cancelled, award adjusted score\*.

If the missing card is found among the cards already played by the deficient hand then Law 67 applies
