Meeting Auckland/Northland Regional Committee

Minutes of previous meeting: Already circulated and approved and Grant has lodged with NZB.

Items for discussion and decision:

1. Regonal Championships (formerly InterProvincials)

The Region had sent out a survey in December to recent trialists and a number of regional players who have in the past trialed and to upcoming players that might be interested in trialing. The committee were pleased with the survey uptake as follows:

- 46 players responded providing a good number and sample.
- A good mix of 2/3 respondents in Auckland and 1/3 Northland achieved.
- Three-quarters of the respondents are for the main Open/Seniors/Women field, a quarter are intermediates.

The committee discussed the survey in depth and took into account all feedback provided. They have drawn up their preliminary recommendations and will seek advice and input from the Chef de Mission before making any final decision. (Action: **Jane**)

2. New committee members

Grant has secured interest from four players in Auckland in joining the regional committee. Jane has two people potentially interested in the secretary role.

Jane to set up 15 min max meetings with each interested person and with Tania to outline the work we do, understand where their interest lies and look at meeting availability schedules. NZB to be advised of any appointments to the Regional Committee following these discussions. (Action: Jane)

3. Discussion additional support for lesson promotion to Auckland clubs

Sufficient in budget remaining to support Auckland clubs not taking up NZB social media advertising opportunity but starting lessons within few weeks of each other. Tutors work extremely hard – important to support them and Region will try to provide extra support this year. Campaign to complement their own club efforts and support NZB social media campaign.
